There will be no admission to the Exhibition Rooms between 10.15 am and 2.00 pm.

SECTION 1 – FLOWERS, VEGETABLES AND FRUIT

FLOWERS

1. **Roses.** 3 blooms of different cultivars in one vase (leaves left on).
2. **Rose.** Single specimen, large flowered (leaves left on).
3. **Rose.** Cluster flowered, 1 stem or spray (leaves left on).
4. **Rose.** A single stem, single or multi-headed, fragrance the principal criterion (leaves left on).
5. **Dahlias.** 5 stems in one vase, same type or different.
6. **Dahlias.** 3 stems in one vase, single type.
7. **Gladioli.** 3 spikes in one vase, same variety or different.
8. **Sweet peas.** 5 stems, mixed.
9. **Cut garden flowers.** Bunch in one vase with 5 different types of flower. Several of each allowed.
10. **Foliage.** 3 varieties of greenery (foliage, herbs (not in flower) and grasses) in one vase. Several stems of each variety allowed.
11. **Hydrangeas.** 3 stems in one vase, same variety or different.
12. **Foliage plant or fern.** In a pot, pot size up to 9"/23cm. Plant must have been in your possession for at least 3 months.
13. **Flowering pot plant.** Any type. In a pot, pot size up to 9"/23cm. Plant must have been in your possession for at least 3 months.

FLORAL ARRANGEMENTS

14. **Herb arrangement** – max. size 30cm x 30cm x 30cm
15. **A Jubilee Year flower arrangement.**- max size 45cm x 45cm x 45cm

VEGETABLES (N.B. please see the notes to exhibiting vegetables on page 5)

16. **Potatoes.** 5 potatoes.
17. **Tomatoes.** 5 tomatoes, cherry.
18. **Tomatoes.** 5 tomatoes, other than cherry.
19. **Runner beans.** 5 beans.
20. **French beans.** 5 beans.
21. **Chilli pappers** - 5 peppers
22. **Courgettes.** 3 courgettes, 4-8"/10-20cm in length.
23. **Beetroot.** 3 beetroot, globe.
24. **Carrots.** 3 carrots.
25. **Onions.** 3 onions.
26. **Shallots.** 6 shallots.
27. **Garlic.** 3 bulbs.
28. **Radishes.** 5 radishes.
29. **Mangetout peas** – 5 pods
30. **Cucumbers.** 2 ridge cucumbers.
31. **Mixed vegetables.** 3 different vegetables (can include salad crops). 3 specimens of each sort.
32. **Vegetable medley.** A collection of up to 6 different varieties of vegetable, shown in a trug or basket.

FRUIT (NB please see the notes to exhibiting fruit on page 5)

33. **Soft fruit.** Plate of soft fruit, single species or mixed.

SECTION 2 – PRODUCE, PHOTOGRAPHY AND CRAFT

PRODUCE

34. **Marmalade.** Pot of marmalade, labelled and dated. Use your own recipe.
35. **Jam.** Pot of jam, labelled and dated. Use your own recipe.
36. **Lemon curd.** Pot of lemon curd, labelled and dated. Use your own recipe.
37. **Chutney.** Pot of chutney, labelled and dated. Use your own recipe.
38. **Jelly** – Pot of jelly, labelled and dated. Use your own recipe

CAKES – OPEN TO ALL

39. **Ladies Cake** - (use recipe provided).
40. **Men's Cake** - (use recipe provided).
41. **Savoury scones.** 4 scones. Use your own recipe.

PHOTOGRAPHY

42. **Reflections**
43. **On a horticultural or agricultural theme** — of the entrant's choice.

CRAFT

44. **An item made from re-cycled materials** — made by the entrant.
45. **A hand-stitched item** — hand- made by the entrant

Rules and regulations

1. Entry form as indicated overleaf. Completed entry forms to be submitted and entries paid for on the evening before the show from 6.00pm to 7.30pm.
2. Exhibits to be staged on the evening before the show from 6.00pm to 7.30pm or on the morning of the show from 9.00 to 10.15am **prompt**. There will be no admission to the Exhibition Halls between 10.15am and 2.00pm. Exhibits may not be removed before 4pm.
3. Limitation of prizes. The judges' decision is final. They may not necessarily award a First Prize if the exhibits in any class are below standard. The Committee will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to any exhibit, but all reasonable care will be taken.
4. The Lockerley and District Horticultural Challenge Cups etc. will be awarded where appropriate and must be returned, polished, after one year by Saturday 30th July to Heather Bowyer, Lockerley Water House, East Tytherley Road, Lockerley, tel. 01794 340640.
5. Vases will be supplied for Classes 1-11 inclusive.
6. **Notes on exhibiting vegetables:** tomatoes must be displayed with the calyx left on. Peas and beans must be displayed with some stalk attached. Carrots and parsnips must have the foliage trimmed back to 3". Onion tops may be tied using raffia or string. Apart from Class 32, vegetables to be arranged on the black plastic table covering provided, no foliage or accessories, such as plates, or rings will be allowed.
7. **Notes on exhibiting fruit:** soft fruit should have stalks attached. Plates will be supplied for displaying fruit.
8. Entries for Classes 39 and 40 must be produced using the recipe provided (copies available from **Lockerley Village Stores, the Coffee Shop, West Tytherley shop and Church entrances**).
9. Photographs for Classes 42 and 43 can be any size, colour or black and white and can be mounted or unmounted.
10. Any re-cycled item made by the entrant is eligible for class 44 and may include any technique. Please detail source of materials. Any hand-stitched item (eg embroidery, quilting, cross stitch etc) hand-stitched by the entrant is eligible for class 45
