St Peter's, West Tytherley

Welcome to April! By the time you read this there will be dates set for the Annual Parochial Church Meetings when a new selection of people will be elected to serve as Churchwardens and be on our Parochial Church Councils. I think it is good to look back on where we have come from. It is important that we should not view the past through 'rose-tinted spectacles'. Some aspects of church life have changed in the last 50 years.

Although we no longer have Sunday Schools we probably have more contact with children than ever before. People from our Churches go into our schools to help with reading, to be Governors and to lead Collective Worship (Assemblies) – we even have an 'Open the Book' Team helping children explore Bible Stories through drama. We now have services in modern language – easier to understand than the language of the Book of Common Prayer (BCP). However, for those of us who like the rich language and inheritance of the BCP its services are available several times each week.

One change is that I have been encouraged (by Bishop Philip, the new Bishop of Winchester) to revert to calling myself your Rural Dean (rather than Area Dean). I think this better reflects the nature of our parishes!
