The Season of Lent covers all of March this year (it started on Ash Wednesday - 22<sup>nd</sup> February) and Easter Day is 9<sup>th</sup> April. Lent is a time for reflection and spiritual renewal in preparation for Good Friday and Christ's resurrection on Easter Sunday. Lent lasts 40 days, a significant number in the Bible:

- In Genesis, rain fell for 40 days and nights in the great flood
- The Israelites spent 40 years in the wilderness before entering the promised land
- Jesus spent 40 days fasting in the wilderness before starting his ministry



In February, I attended the General Synod of the Church of England in London – you may have seen the media coverage of the debates! Many of the debates centred on the outcomes of 'Living in Love and Faith' (a 5-year project for the Church to think about identity, sexuality, relationships and marriage). The end result was to welcome proposals which would enable same-sex couples to come to church after a civil marriage or civil partnership to give thanks, dedicate their relationship to God and receive God's blessing. The Cost of Living Crisis was also discussed and decisions made as to how people could be helped.
