Lockerley Mobile Phone Mast

There is a proposal to erect a 20 metre high mobile phone mast on Lockerley Green which is Registered Common Land owned by the Parish Council. The Parish Council has publicly stated that whilst it supports the provision of good mobile phone coverage for the area Lockerley Green is not a suitable location for a mast! Other sites have been proposed.

The Parish Council has formed a sub-committee to help address the issue made up of 3 councillors and 3 local residents. Further information can be found on the Lockerley Parish Council web site or:

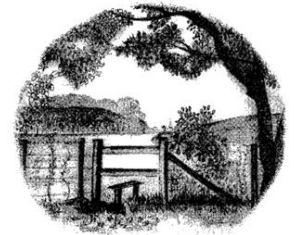

Lockerley Stores Defibrillator Update

The new Defibrillator has recently been delivered (slightly later than hoped for) and will be sited on the outside of Lockerley Stores. By the time you read this it should be in place and available for use if the need arises. Once again, a huge thank you to you all for your generous donations. In total the amount raised was £2037. This more than covers the cost of the machine and cabinet. It means we have a small sum in hand that can be used for maintenance (eg new specialist replacement batteries which will be needed every four years or so).

It is reassuring to know we have the ability to act fast should someone have a cardiac arrest and along with the defibrillator outside the village hall there is now better access across our village community.

Please make time to read the information sheet alongside the Defibrillator as soon as you can so that you know what to do in an emergency. It could save valuable time should you need to make use of it.

The Christian holiday of Pentecost is a moveable feast, which is celebrated on the 50th day (the seventh Sunday) from Easter Sunday (Sunday 23rd May 2021). It commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus Christ while they were in Jerusalem celebrating the Feast of Weeks, as described in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 2:1-31). The holiday is also called "White Sunday" or "Whitsunday" or "Whitsun", especially in the United Kingdom, where traditionally the next day, Whit Monday, was also a public holiday (since 1971 fixed by statute on the last Monday in May).
