Downfall of Worn-out Lockerley Green Climbing Frame

Lockerley Parish Council at their September meeting discussed a recent engineers safety inspection conducted on the old play frame situated on Lockerley Green. The play frame is in excess of 20 years old and the safety inspection report highlighted the wooden frame has rotted weakening the structure. The Parish Council having considered the options which were repair, replace or remove decided the play frame should be removed. The Parish Council also took into consideration that the safety inspection report recommended additional associated work may also be necessary at the site if the play frame was to remain. The Parish Council further took into account the additional cost implications if the old play frame was to be repaired or replaced having regard to the fact that Lockerley now has a new play area with modern play equipment.

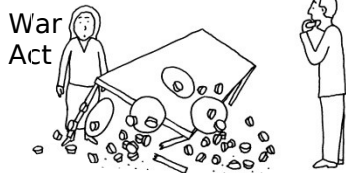

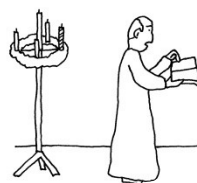

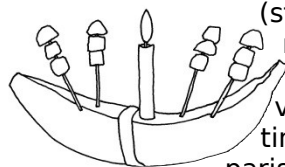
