Useful 'New' stamps Information!

The Royal Mail is adding barcodes to all our regular 'everyday' stamps. The new stamps will continue to feature the profile of our head of state, current stamps will continue to carry Her Majesty the Queen Elizabeth II, but this will eventually change to His Majesty King Charles III. The barcodes system will enable the introduction of new services by connecting physical stamps to the digital world through the Royal Mail app.

Non-barcoded stamps can be exchanged for the new version through the 'Stamp Swap Out' scheme. You have until 31 January 2023. To swap out your stamps simply complete one of our Stamp Swap Out forms and send it to the Royal Mail with your non-barcoded stamps.

Please note: special stamps with picture on and Christmas Stamps without a barcode will continue to be valid and don't need to be swapped out.

How to get a 'Stamp Swap Out' form.

Swap out up to £200 worth of non-barcoded stamps by printing out and completing the stamp swap form that can be found via the following location:

www.royalmail.com/sending/barcoded-stamps

If you don't have access to the internet, you can obtain a 'Stamp Swap Out' form from the Customer Service Point at your local Royal Mail Delivery Office, **not Sub Post Offices.**Alternatively call the Customer Experience Team on 03457 740740 (Calls to 03 numbers cost no more than a national rate call to a 01 or 02 number from your phone).


