#### **Future of Lockerley Parish Room**

Lockerley Parish Council would welcome residents views on the future of the Parish Room (the building located between the village church and the Scout hut). The Parish Council own the building, which only has one regular user, Lockerley Silver Band.

The Victorian building requires essential repairs, as well as additional expenditure to bring it up to modern safety and regulatory standards for the purposes of a commercial building to which the public has access. This would incur substantial cost to the taxpayer which the Parish Council consider is not economically viable nor justified given the very limited use of the building and the availability of the Memorial Hall which is the social hub for the village. The Parish Room does not generate any income and the costs of maintaining it fall entirely to the Parish Council.

No decision on the future of building has yet been made. One consideration would be to sell the building, subject to any appropriate approvals that might be required and safeguards as to the use of proceeds from the sale.



WHAT WAS THE VICAR WEARING THIS MORNING? EASTER SUNDAY KIND OF RABBIT LUNCH

In our churches we are planning for: Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday - Simple Evening Communion Services at different churches around the Benefice (Monday – Wellow; Tuesday – West Tytherley; Wednesday – Sherfield English)

The week before Easter (14<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> April) is called Ho-

ly Week and is there to help people prepare for Easter.

Maundy Thursday – A service called 'Tenebrae', characterized by gradual extinguishing of candles at Lock-

**Good Friday** – a 3-hour vigil remembering the 3 hours that Christ spent on the cross (with a procession from Lockerley Green to East Dean Church, starting at 11am). This will be a service where all ages can come and go, arriving and leaving when they please. There will be quiet, music and words to help our reflections. In the evening come to Lockerley (6pm) where the choir will be leading 'The Cross of Christ' - the story of

Jesus' suffering and death on the cross told through hymns, anthems and bible readings. (Duration about 1 hour). Easter Sunday - The early morning service combines: a Vigil (waiting for Dawn outside the church); with the Service of Light (with procession and lighting of new 'Paschal Candle'); a reminder about Baptism (in the early Church, Easter was the only time for baptisms) and an Easter Communion. This will be followed by a light, celebratory breakfast.

Please take the opportunity to come and prepare for Easter.
