Lockerley Walking Group

Join us for a 6 mile walk from Stockbridge on Fri 5 Dec. Starting with a short stretch south on the Test Way, we loop around across farmland to the east then north, across Stockbridge Down then Leckford Golf Course before heading back on the Test Way to our start, with lunch in the White Hart. No stiles, good conditions underfoot, one short steep ascent (~150 feet) early on, mostly gentle thereafter.

Meet at Lockerley Memorial Hall, Butts Green at 0930 to share transport. In Stockbridge we'll park in the parking area on the stretch of the A30 between the roundabout north of the White Hart pub and the next roundabout at the junction between the A3057 toward Leckford and the A30 toward Sutton Scotney – anyone going straight there, aim to arrive about 0950.
