

Definitely into the Autumn now – with plenty of Harvest events and entertainment. There is the Lockerley & East Dean Harvest Supper on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> October. We have 2 Animal Services (2pm on 12<sup>th</sup> October at Canada Common Church and 2pm on 19<sup>th</sup> October at East Tytherley Church). Hopefully, East Tytherley Church will be tidied in time for the 7pm Flute and Accordion Concert on the 19<sup>th</sup>! West Tytherley are hosting an Audience with Sir Patrick Cordingley at 7pm on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> October. Details of these events (and others) are on the Churches Facebook page (detailed below).

At Harvest we also try to give some food to needy people. This year, again, parishes are supporting the Romsey Foodbank, part of Trussell Trust (www.romsey.foodbank.org.uk). In the last year, 627 families received 7-day supplies of food and necessaries – over 6,000 meals. In the cost-of-living crisis there will be even more families in need. Many churches are collecting food all year round, not just at Harvest (including St Margaret's, Wellow and St John's, Lockerley). There are drop off points too in Romsey Abbey, Waitrose, Botley Road Co-op, Abbotswood Co-op, The Hundred Co-op, Ganger Farm, Henshaw Fox and Romsey Library. The current Shopping List includes: Cup-a-Soup; Tinned Potatoes; Rice; Microwave Rice; Desserts; Biscuit Bars; Crisps; Chocolate; Sweets; and, Peanut Butter. If you can afford to do so, please give generously. We also need to keep supporting the church financially – the money that goes on 'Parish Share' pays for our local clergy.
